Paris is nicknamed the "City of Light" because it was one of the first cities in the world to use streetlights.

The **River Seine** runs through the middle of Paris and has **37 bridges** just inside the city.

Paris has **more dogs than children**, and many cafés even offer water bowls for pups!

The **Paris Métro (subway)** has over **300 stations**, and some are filled with art and music.

There are **more than 1,800 bakeries** in Paris—no wonder Piper smells bread everywhere!


The city is divided into **20 neighborhoods**, called **arrondissements**, that spiral out like a snail shell.

The world's first public zoo opened in Paris in 1793 during the French Revolution.

The **oldest café in Paris**, Café Procope, opened in **1686** and once served famous thinkers like Voltaire and Benjamin Franklin.
